Title IV, state, outside scholarships, and some study abroad scholarships, like the Buckman Fellowship, may be used for study abroad programs as long as Rhodes accepts academic credit and a consortium agreement exists. Consortium agreements on programs in which Rhodes-funded aid may not be used are generally done on a student-by-student basis. Alternative loans may be used for any program. If the student desires to utilize this option for Maymester or summer study abroad programs, the costs of said programs may be added to the spring term and the disbursement date set for disbursement in late spring. The student's account must be paid in full for the student to receive the alternative loan disbursement for the Maymester or summer program.
